## Instructions: Rural Opportunity Fund and Small Business Opportunity Fund Certificate of Contribution for Tax Credit

Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-4-2109(I) provides a credit for financial institutions that contribute to the Tennessee rural opportunity fund or the Tennessee small business opportunity fund of 10% of the contribution amount. The credit can be taken each year for 10 years, beginning the year in which the contribution was made.
